## Kitchen

**The kitchen is equipped with everything you will need during your stay. Pots, pans, dishes, glasses, cups, cutlery, utensils, microwave, propane stove, propane oven, coffee maker, toaster, and a fridge. To use the kitchen appliances, please read the following steps:**

### Oven & Stove

**For the propane oven or stove, turn knob to ignite, once flame is lit, adjust temperature accordingly.**



## Living Room

**The couch in the common area will fold out into a sofa bed for extra bedding if required. The ladder for the bunk beds can be found in the closet beside the washroom.**



## Outdoor Patio

**A firepit is provided with the trailer where you can enjoy a campfire and/or watch the sunset. Please purchase wood from the Campground store as we don't allow outside firewood. Please keep firepit in spot where it is placed.**




## Smoking

Please do not smoke inside the trailer, but feel free to smoke outside and use ashtray containers for butts.



## Parking

Please park beside the Golden Falcon trailer. We will provide you with a parking pass upon check-in. Extra vehicles, please park in our parking lot down by the water.



## Pets

Unfortunately, we do not allow pets in our trailer rentals.



## Miscellaneous

### Swimming

Please keep in mind that the swimming conditions vary every year. The shoreline is a flat rock on the Bay of Quinte. Moss on the rocks and Zebra mussels are present in the water. Water shoes are highly recommended. A beach pass is available to borrow from our County Shores Office/Store. Please reserve the pass ahead of time. It will allow you to get into the world-famous Sandbanks Provincial Park as well as North Beach Provincial Park and Lake on the Mountain Provincial Park.

### Drinking Water

The Golden Falcon trailer water is treated, tested daily and is safe to drink. You are welcome to bring your own. Please practice water conservation while staying in our trailer. No long showers, washing of clothes, cars, trucks, pets or boats allowed at any time.



## Heating & Air Conditioning

### Air Conditioner

The Golden Falcon trailer is equipped with an air conditioning unit. Please keep doors and windows shut, and curtains or blinds closed when using the air conditioner. Please turn it on the economy setting when leaving for a day trip. Please turn the units off when leaving at the end of your stay. If there is a problem, please report it immediately.

### Thermostat

The Golden Falcon trailer has an electric furnace. Please use only when needed and turn them down during the nighttime.



## Trash / Recycling

Garbage bags and a recycling box are provided with the Golden Falcon Trailer. Please recycle as much as possible. A recycling poster is in the binder. Never leave garbage outside unless in the large garbage container with the lid locked tight. This is to ensure that our nighttime visitors (E.g. Raccoons and skunks) do not get into it. If your recycling or garbage becomes full, it is renter's responsibility to bring it to the main campground drop off area.



## Check out

**We hope you enjoyed your stay at our Golden Falcon Trailer! Please read over our check list for checking out before you leave:**

- Check-out by 10:00 am – Cleaner arrives at this time to prepare for next guest**
- Bathroom towels left in bathroom/tub**
- Dishes cleaned and put away**
- Furniture left or put back where it was upon arrival**
- Empty fridge and cupboards of any food items brought**
- Check to make sure you are not leaving anything behind**
- Garbage and recycling taken to our Garbage/Recycling area by campground office**
- Thermostats/Air Conditioning Units set to original setting upon arrival**
- All lights turned off**
- Lock door and return keys and Provincial Park Pass(es) to the campground office. Failure to do so will result in a \$100.00 charge to your credit card.**
- Any damage or failure to leave clean will result in possible charges. We will call you to explain what was found and discuss a charge with you.**

## General Rules

- All people and vehicles must stop at office before entering campgrounds or rental units.
- No vehicles allowed on pier area without special permission.
- Please keep campgrounds clean and safe.
- All recycling and garbage to be placed in containers near office.
- No fireworks at any time.
- No firearms shall be kept or discharged within any part of the campground.
- No alcohol permitted other than on a camp site or rental unit.
- No smoking or use of cannabis is permitted other than on campsite.
- No smoking or use of cannabis is permitted in rental units. Failure to comply will result in a \$250.00 service charge.
- All fish cleaning to be done at cleaning stations at the rental boat dock area.
- Pets to be on a leash at all times. Pets not to be left unattended at any time. No aggressive dogs allowed in the campground. Please ask to see our pet policy for further details. Additional fees may apply.
- No boats to be left in boat ramp at any time.
- No washing of RV's, trailers, boats or vehicles at any time.
- No racing or reckless driving of any sort will be tolerated.
- Check in is at 4:00 PM. Check out is at 10:00 am.
- Quiet hours are from 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM – No excessive noise from people, radios or animals at any time. Please be considerate of your neighbours.
- Fire pot are not to be removed without permission – no burning of pallets allowed.
- Fire pots are not to be left with garbage in them.
- Fires must always be supervised by an adult and thoroughly put out with water.
- No clothes lines attached to trees.
- This rental covers a maximum of 4 people.
- Visitors must register at office before entering park or rentals and leave before 11:00 PM.
